

The Plot

- Russel is a teen guy that is not ready to accept his homosexuality.
- One day at the park he meet another guy, Kevin,a football player in the school's team. They begin to hang out and finally they kiss.
- A girl saw them and they are both afraid of rumours and gossip about their relationship.
- At School they pretend not to know each other, as they are not ready to "coming out".

The girl, Min, is actually a member of the secret support group for homosexuals (together with her girlfriend and another boy), called the Geography Club, and invites Russel to be a part of it.

Even if he is suspicious, he finally accept and begin to feel comfortable in the club.

Meanwhile, Russel pretends to have a girlfriend, Trish, which is really interested in him, but he understands immediately that he is not comfortable with this situation

- At the same time Russel get more involved (and seriously in love) with Kevin.
- Kevin decides to place Russel in the team, in order to see him more, and he invites him at home too.
- Russel finds out that Kevin's family is very open towards homosexuality (contrary to his parents), but he still doesn't want to tell them he's gay.
- As the weeks go by, he feels really frustrated and uneasy and when some people start yelling at him "fag" because he didn't sleep with Trish, he decides to stop pretending, even if Kevin does not approve.

- He suggests to create the official club for gay and lesbian, and the geography club agrees immediately: they are all ready to show who they really are!
- Russel gives an ultimatum to Kevin: if he won't join the club, they will be over. Kevin, too scared, decides to leave.
- The film ends with Russel, finally free and sure of his choices, even if he has lost Kevin.
- Understand and accept who he really was, made his life a lot better.

The Characters

RUSSEL: At the beginning of the film he is not sure of who he really is. He is in love with Kevin, the only one with whom he really feel himself and comfortable. He recibes a lot of pressure from his father (to go to a good university and have a traditional family). At the end of the film he accepts who he really wants to be, because is the only way to finally feel free and confidence.


